MESSAGE FROM THE ACTING DIRECTOR GENERAL - EDUCATION

Mandatory COVID-19 vaccinations

This morning (Tuesday) the Premier has announced a new Health Direction for workers in high risk settings.

From 23 January 2022, mandatory COVID-19 vaccinations will be required for all people delivering a service at a school or an early childhood education and care setting. This includes contractors, volunteers, regulators and auditors.

All people who are delivering a service on these sites will need to have had their first dose of the COVID-19 vaccination by 17 December 2021 and the second completed by 23 January 2022.

Further information will be provided as soon as possible about how this new requirement will be managed within the Department of Education.

We have worked hard to remain COVID-safe since the pandemic began, and this new vaccination requirement will play a critical role in keeping each other, and the students and children in our care, safe.

Thank you to everyone who has already made a commitment to be vaccinated for their own protection and that of the community we support.

Right now, my key message to you is to get vaccinated.

I strongly encourage you to view the vaccination locations webpage and arrange your vaccination as soon as possible.

Ensuring as many Queenslanders as possible are vaccinated is the most effective way for us all to stay safe as we continue to enjoy relaxed restrictions and achieve Queensland's COVID vaccine plan to unite families.
